HOW TO FIND US

From the South: From NYS Thruway take Exit 31, go north on NYS 12 into downtown Lowville. Located on the right one block before third traffic light.

From the West: From NYS Thruway take Exit 36, go north on NYS 81 to Exit 42. Follow NYS 177 east to NYS 12 (Approx. 25 minutes). Follow NYS 12 east into downtown Lowville. Turn right at traffic light. Located on left less than 0.25 miles.

From the North: Take NYS 12 south from Watertown into downtown Lowville. Turn right at traffic light. Located on left less than 0.25 miles.

**Free parking to the side and rear of building.
Handicap accessible!**
